- 2- Handicap: Why do we have different Summer and Winter handicaps? Even though less boats race in winter, they are still the same boats racing in summer. eg. Chinook's handicap varied by 3 min. from its last summer race of the series to the first winter race series the following week, its handicap carrying over from its last winter race. But that last winter last race was many months earlier. If a boat sails only summer series, then why not retain its handicap until the following summer series.
- 3- Presentation: Personally, I prefer the presentation at Club as existing. Better Comradery between skippers / crews.
- 4- Course: Generally happy with the existing course format but could consider lengthen course / distance between rounding marks and do only two laps rather than the three. (Same race time but longer legs)

Response:

- 1- It would be good to start earlier. I will ask all Wednesday twi-light sailors if they can start at 5pm. It is a matter of who we may lose if we start earlier. RMYC Toronto start 1700, RMYC Broken Bay start 1700?
- 2- Although we may have some boats in both the numbers are quite different. This can cause a shift in the mean and results in an offset and not necessarily difference in real times. If we adapt a longer course for Afternoon, this will also impact on the adjustments.
- 3- No plans to change the presentation format.
- 4- Difficult to lengthen windward legs above .6 nM and to remain in the inshore area to race under cat 7 unless we add additional items to cat 7. May be possible to lengthen to 0.7nM?

Race qs

Race qs is an online yacht tracking application which runs on an android or IOS (iPhone) smart phone. The application is free to download. Once the track is completed it can be uploaded to a web-based application. The web-based application which can run on windows or OS computer. The web-based application can have multiple users to view the post-racetrack of all yachts or a selected group of yachts.

It is capable to track a yacht or group of yachts participating in a race around specific mark. The race can be Selected as a scratch or pursuit start at a given specific time.

It can also track a yachts making a passage.

The web-based application has a very useful tool for post-race analytics of your yacht or a fleet of yachts.

The applications have tutorials to assist in using the application, setting up a series of races and analysing the performance.

Recommendations

Courses

Discussion took place on the pros and cons of lengthening the Afternoon race. There are practical issues of extending the windward leg (see course diagrams following) and although time may permit at the beginning and end of the series, sunset allows less than 2 hours in the middle of the series. Conclusion: Courses to remain as published in the handbook for both Twilight and Afternoons.

Start Time

5:30 start necessary to complete by sunset at beginning of series, latter start needed to allow many skippers and crew to sail, so start times to remain for Twilight and Afternoon – governed by sunset and a balance for as many as possible boats to sail.


Tender

Problems getting back to the club in time for presentation which is part of the reason for asking for earlier starts. For the reasons above it is not in the interest of many Skippers to start early so we need to streamline the arrangements for picking up crew. Many issues were discussed including lack of space to drop crew off. This will be taken up with the sailing committee who will come up with a more efficient pickup service.

Notification

Cruising/Social notes

After discussion last night I was thinking that as suggested we incorporate into the sailing program the cruising activities and looking for some suitable dates.

- Summer sailing season, "Raft up" overnighter: (Early in the summer sailing calendar) Schedule for say Sat/Sun 9/10th Oct or 23/24th Oct in the program. These dates the tides are favourable and in Daylight saving time. Yacht's anchor adjacent to sand bar, north of Lilli Pilli point and meet for a Happy Hour on the sand bar at low tide (mid-afternoon). Schedule for high tide mid-morning so yachts navigate up-river in the morning and return late morning the following day. This could be an "ice breaker" for the start of the season introducing new yachts into the fleet. Yachts can remain for the evening adjacent to the sand bar or pick up a mooring along the National Park. Sail back home on the morning rising tide on the Sunday. If weather is not suitable, we could change it to SW arm.
- Cruise and Overnighter Frenchman's Bay: (Mid December or Late January). Yachts depart
 Saturday at a scheduled time from Port Hacking sail to Frenchman's Bay for a Happy hour
 on the beach or meeting at the Cafe. Late get up and coffee at cafe and then scheduled start
 for a return sail to PH. Could run a handicap race for the Saturday PH-FB and Sunday FBPH. Courses use the Bass and Flinders Start and finish a lateral line from Captain Cook
 Buoy to Bare Island Light. The reverse for the sail back on the Sunday.
- Happy hour Jibbon Beach; (Late Summer season). Yachts meet on a Saturday afternoon for happy hour on the beach. Stay overnight or return.

Happy to discuss some firm dates with you or open it up to discussion at the next skippers feedback meeting that you are planning.
